WHEREAS, the scientific consensus is clear that human activities are primarily responsible for the warming that is accelerating global climate change; and

**RESOLUTION No.** 

WHEREAS, changes in Oregon's climate are already being felt, with Oregon's mean emperature warming by 2.2°F per century during 1895-2015, and 2015 was the varmest year on record and 2016 was the wettest winter on record, and

VHEREAS, the Oregon Climate Change Research Institute has found that climate hange poses a significant threat to Cregon's forestry, hencies, water supplies and zestail resources, and impacts that are likely to include writer fooding, summer roughts, loss of shorehin, forest fires, climinished film and widdle habitut, retreating lackies, documents, document fires, climinished film and widdle habitut, retreating lackies, documents, document fires, documents, such and eti filandes.

VHEREAS, the City of Portland's climate future is expected to be characterized by other, drier summers with more high-heat days, and warmer winters with more intense ain events. "Oregon's mean annual temperature is projected to increase by up to 10.7"F ry the 2080s (compared to the 1970-1999 average) if we don't act; and


WHEREAS, the entire community will be impacted by climate change, but communities that already face existing socioeconomic and health inequilies will be most severely mounted by these risks, including inditien, older adults, people of coor, and people in overty, and such communities will therefore require an investment in resilience that is severity and such communities will therefore require an investment in resilience that is severity and such communities.

WHEREAS, the newly confirmed EPA Administrator Scott Pruitt and President Trump are making decisions that are setting climate policy back decades by defunding environmental programs, attempting to reinvigorate the coal industry, greenlighting major pipeline projects (such as Keystone XL and Dakota Access), attacking the Clean Drawer Dien and Lawarance EDA's committent the analycomardial statics; and

WHEREAS, the Oregon Global Warming Commission concluded in its 2017 report to the Legislature that Oregon is not on track to achieve its statutory greenhouse gas reduction gais, specifically to reduce emissions by 10 percent by 2020 and by 75 percent by 2050; and


WHEREAS, the City of Portland has committed to policies opposing new fossil fuel infrastructure because of the inherent dangers to health and safety in extraction, transport, storage, and combustion of fossil fuels which are exacerbated by the spec seismic profile of this region; and

HEREAS, the economic opportunities presented by a clean energy transition tweigh the opportunities to expanding the fossil fuel economy; and Page 1 of 5




# Investing in a balanced transportation system
